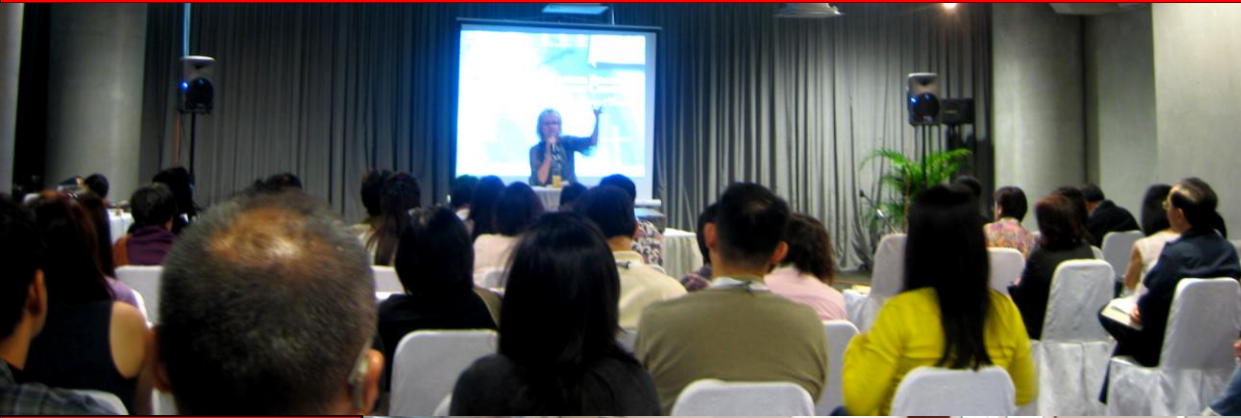

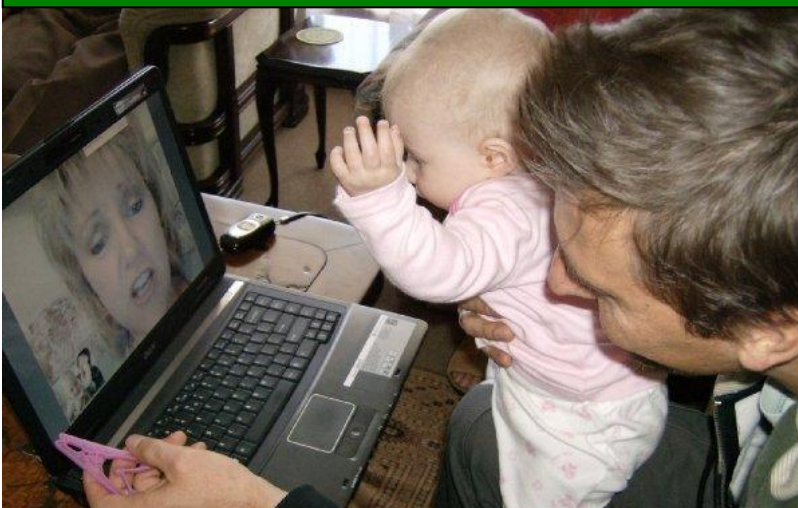
**With Kimberley Douglas, a friend from Australia, after we both had just shared the Word at the St Albans Men's Prison in Port Elizabeth.**
